AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Ms. MURKOWSKI

Viz:

- 1 At the end of subtitle A of title VII, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 705. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE INSPECTOR GENERAL**
- 3 **REPORT ON THEFT OF COMPUTER TAPES**
- 4 **CONTAINING PROTECTED INFORMATION ON**
- 5 **COVERED BENEFICIARIES UNDER THE**
- 6 **TRICARE PROGRAM.**

7 The Inspector General of the Department of Defense

8 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-

9 port on the circumstances surrounding the theft of com-

1 puter tapes containing personally identifiable and pro-
2 tected health information of approximately 4,900,000 cov-
3 ered beneficiaries under the TRICARE program from the
4 vehicle of a contractor under the TRICARE program. The
5 report shall include the following:

6 (1) An assessment of the risk that the person-
7 ally identifiable and protected health information so
8 stolen can be accessed by a third party.

9 (2) Such recommendations as the Inspector
10 General considers appropriate to reduce the risk of
11 similar incidents in the future.
