Dear Senator Murkowski,

This letter is an informational notice that we have ended the U.S. Postal Service's Area Mail Processing (AMP) study of mail processing operations at the Juneau, AK, Customer Service Mail Processing Center. The reason for the study was to help us identify whether consolidation of selected mail-processing functions would help eliminate excess capacity and make better use of facility space, staffing, equipment and transportation.

After careful review, it has been determined that there are currently no significant opportunities to improve efficiency or service through consolidation of mail processing operations at the Juneau, AK, Customer Service Mail Processing Center. As a result, no changes will be made at this time.
