Dear Applicant:

Each year, I have the privilege of nominating outstanding Alaskan students for appointment to one of the four United States service academies. The President of the United States officially makes all appointments to the United States service academies. However, each member of Congress is allotted a limited number of nominations that we may submit for consideration of an appointment by an individual service academy to fill vacancies at each academy. The process is highly competitive and securing a nomination does not guarantee an appointment or offer of admission. You are encouraged to apply to as many nomination sources as you are eligible, including your Congressional Delegation and the Vice President of the United States.

To assist with this nomination process, I ask candidates to submit the attached application packet that documents their academic, civic, and athletic abilities, as well as their commitment to military service. The complete application package must be <u>received</u> in my Anchorage office no later than November 10, 2023.

To apply, an applicant must meet the following eligibility requirements:

□ Age: Must be at least 17 years old but not older than 23 on July 1 st of the year of admission (25 for the Merchant Marine Academy).
☐ Citizenship/Residency: Must be a U.S. citizen and a legal and permanent resident of the State of Alaska.
☐ Marital Status: Must be unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents.

My office requires the following information to evaluate your request for nomination:

- Completed U.S. Military Service Academy Nomination Application from our website submitted on time to the Office of U.S. Senator Lisa Murkowski with an attached photograph.
- Proof of Alaska Residency: Provide a copy of your Alaska voter registration card or Alaska Driver's License (or a copy of your parent's Alaska voter registration or Alaska Driver's License if you do not yet have one of these items). Military Dependents living outside of Alaska must provide the military parent's current rank and duty information and proof of Alaska residency, such as a Leave and Earnings Statement.
- Essay: In 200 words or less, provide a typed essay answering the questions in the "Essay" section of the application.
- Two Evaluations: Please provide two complete letters of evaluation from adults in your life. (For example: Teacher, Coach, Boss, Counselor, or Principal). Do not include letters from your family members. Return with application, completed and sealed with signature over envelope flap.
- Academic Information:

- 1. Sealed official transcripts from all high schools, junior colleges or colleges you have attended.
- 2. Copy or photo of official SAT or ACT test score report (if not shown on transcript).

Applicants may be interviewed by a review panel, depending on availability and other factors, including but not limited to the competitiveness and number of applications received for the application period.

It is the responsibility of each applicant to make sure their Military Service Academy Nomination Application is complete before it is submitted to Senator Murkowski's office. No incomplete applications will be considered. All applications must be received in the Anchorage District Office by November 10, 2023.

VI. Evaluations.

Please submit two completed letters of evaluation. One should be from a teacher or coach, and the second from a principal, school counselor or a work-related reference. Do not include references from your family members. Please submit each evaluation with the Evaluator's signature across the envelope flap with your application.

VII. Academic Transcripts and Test Scores.

Please submit a sealed official transcript from all high schools, junior colleges or colleges you have attended.

If not listed on your transcript, please submit your SAT and/or ACT scores either directly from the testing service or provide a copy. (Applicants are responsible for confirming whether SAT and ACT scores are listed on official transcripts). The copy must be of the official scores from the printed copy or from the online portal that includes the applicant's name. Applications listing just the test score numbers will not be accepted.

If submitting scores directly from the testing service, our SAT testing code is 4471 and our ACT testing code is 7103.

	a Sealed Official Transcripts: From all high schools, junior colleges, or colleges you have attended.
	b Copy of SAT/ACT scores: If not listed on your transcript, please provide your scores directly from the testing service (SAT code: 4471; ACT code: 7103) OR a copy/photo of your official scores. The copy must be of the official scores from the printed copy or the online portal that applicant's name. We will not accept just the numbers.

These items must be received in the Anchorage Office no later than November 10, 2021 to be considered for a nomination from this office. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
