# U.S. MILITARY SERVICE ACADEMY NOMINATION APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

May 1, 2018

#### **Dear Applicant:**

Each year I have the privilege of nominating outstanding Alaskan students for appointment to one of the four service academies. The President of the United States officially makes all appointments to the United States service academies. However, each member of Congress is allotted a limited number of nominations, which they may submit for consideration of an appointment (by the academy) to fill the vacancies at each academy. The entire process is highly competitive, and securing a nomination does not guarantee an appointment or offer of admission. You are therefore encouraged to apply to as many sources as you are eligible, including, but not limited to, your Congressional Delegation and the Vice-President of the United States.

To assist with this process, I ask candidates to submit an application packet that documents their academic, civic, and athletic abilities, as well as their commitment to military service. The complete application package must be <u>received</u> in my Anchorage office no later than December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

Each applicant seeking a nomination from my office must meet the following eligibility requirements:

Age: Must be at least 17 years old, but not yet have passed the 23rd birthday. (25 for the Merchant Marine Academy)
☐ <b>Citizenship/Residency:</b> Must be a U.S. citizen and a legal and permanent resident of the State of Alaska.
☐ <b>Marital Status:</b> Must be unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents.

In addition to applying to my office for a nomination, you must also complete and separately submit the requisite admissions application to your academy or academies of choice. It is your responsibility to ensure that the service academies to which you are applying open an admissions file for you. I encourage you to begin your application process to the academies immediately. You can contact each academy by using the information listed below.

#### My office requires the following information to evaluate your request for nomination:

- Completed U.S. Military Service Academy Nomination Application from the Office of U.S. Senator Lisa Murkowski.
- Proof of Alaska Residency: Copy of personal or parents' voter registration. Military
  Dependents living outside of Alaska must provide the military parent's current rank
  and duty information, and proof of Alaska residency, such as a Leave and Earnings
  Statement.
- Essay: In 200 words or less, provide a typed essay answering the questions in the "Essay" section of the application.
- Two Evaluations: Please use attached forms to complete two separate evaluations from adults in your life. For example, a teacher, coach, boss, counselor, or principal. Please do not include letters from your family members. Return the evaluations with your application, completed and sealed (with signature over envelope flap).

#### Academic Information:

- 1. Sealed official transcripts from all high schools, junior colleges or colleges you have attended.
- 2. Copy or photo of official SAT or ACT test score report (if not shown on transcript).

It is the responsibility of each applicant to make sure that your Military Service Academy nomination packet is complete before it is submitted to Senator Murkowski's office. Incomplete packets will not be considered. All complete packets must be received in the Anchorage District Office by 5:00 p.m. on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

One should be from a teacher or coach, and the second from a principal, school counselor or work-related reference. Please do not include references from your family members. Please return the evaluation with the signature across the envelope flap.

#### VII. Academic:

Please submit a sealed official transcript from all high schools, junior colleges, or colleges you have attended.

If not listed on your transcript, please submit your SAT and/or ACT scores either directly from the testing service or provide a copy or photo\*. The copy must be of the official scores (from the printed copy or from the online portal). We will <u>not</u> accept just the numbers.

If submitting scores directly from the testing agency, our SAT testing code is **4471** and our ACT testing code is **7103**.

\*Applicants are responsible for confirming whether or not SAT and ACT scores are listed on your school's official transcripts.
