**A BILL**

To amend the Community Services Block Grant Act to clarify that the maximum allotment provision does not apply to supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2020.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Community Services  
5 Block Grant Refinement and Improvement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON MAXIMUM ALLOTMENT REQUIRE-**  
2 **MENT.**

3 Section 675B(b)(3) of the Community Services Block  
4 Grant Act (42 U.S.C. 9906(b)(3)) is amended by adding  
5 at the end the following: “The reduction required by this  
6 paragraph shall not apply to any funds appropriated  
7 under the CARES Act or any subsequent supplemental  
8 appropriations bill for fiscal year 2020, including any such  
9 funds that remain available for another fiscal year.”.
