- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Summer Meals Act
- 5 of 2021".
- 6 SEC. 2. SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN.
- 7 (a) Better Integrate Summer Education and
- 8 Summer Meals Program.—Section 13(a)(1)(A)(i) of
